FUND OBJECTIVE & STRATEGY

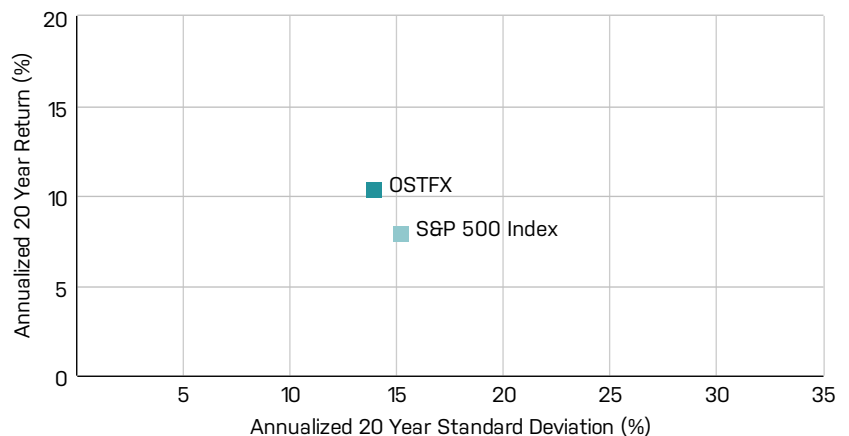

In selecting investments, the Adviser focuses on companies that it believes to be undervalued or otherwise out-of-favor in the market, but that have attractive growth prospects.

Where the benchmark is the Russell 2000 Growth, the iShares Russell 2000 Growth ETF is used as a proxy. Where the S&P 500 is the benchmark, the iShares S&P 500 ETF is used as a proxy.
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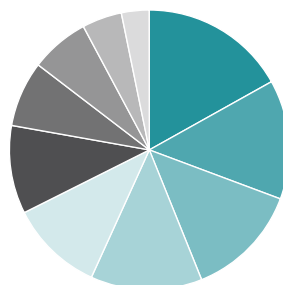

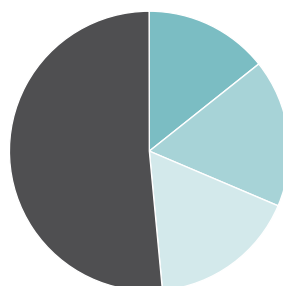
